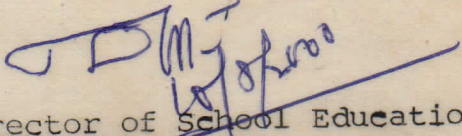

With reference to your letter dated. 18th July '2000...
recognition/upgradation is granted to Siang Model School...
Pasighat.....run and managed by Yaper Taloh Memorial Educational
Society, Pasighat...for running classes upto Primary/Middle/
Secondary standard with effect from 1/8/2000..... the
date of approval from competent authority.

* The recognition is granted on the following
terms and conditions:-

1. The guidelines in respect of recognition of school conveyed through order NO. EDA.20/90-91 (Pt) dated 12th Sept'92 shall have to be observed in letter and spirit.

Further, the recognition of the school does not carry any financial commitment from the Govt. side.

In addition, the following additional guidelines shall be strictly complied with.

2. Arunachal's traditional culture must be preserved.
3. Syllabus prescribed by the Directorate of School Education AP/CBSE, NEW Delhi, for the School will have to be followed.
4. No religious activity should be undertaken either directly or indirectly in the school/Hostel campus.
5. There should be emphasis on the quality Education.
6. Norms of recognition applicable in respect of other institutions shall also be applicable to the institution.
7. Direct or indirect violation noticed in respect of the above mentioned conditions may lead to deterrent action including closure of the school.
8. Govt. will not be bound to provide any land allotment in case of any such school.
9. The question of Govt. grant in appropriate cases will however, be considered only if such schools meet all the stringent rules and regulations prescribed for other voluntary organisation schools.
10. NO Church, temple, Mosque or any other religious activity shall be carried out within the school campus.

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11. No preaching etc. in the guise of Seminar,^D Discourse talk by any religious body or patrons or preachers of any religious institution will be acceptable.
12. The principal of the school and the Secretary of the Governing body must report to the prescribed Govt. authority from time to time to indicate whether the above mentioned Govt. instructions are being observed.
13. The Deputy Commissioner of the District or any representative authorised by him or DSE will be free to obtain necessary feed-back from any such school by way of inspections/calling for report etc.
14. If in the view of DC, there is any communal turn due to any reason relating to such religious activity in the school or if any dis-affection is caused among the students because of the same, then the DC will have right to initiate appropriate action against the authorities of the school and he shall suitably ~~inform~~ the Govt. about the action taken and the Govt. may take suitable action.
